CLINIC

Many patients continue to get treatment at the clinic. Because of starvation in the community, we need food to help them. We also need medicine and vitamins.



Malnutrition, malaria, tuberculosis and worms are the major problems. The clinic is also a door open to save souls.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

Our teachers are very faithful although they do not get paid on time. Their pay is sometimes two or three months late but they continue to work without complaint.



Many of the children abandon school because of starvation.

We are not able to give them one hot meal a day this year.

One dollar a day can feed a child each day and ten dollars can support a child in school for one month

The school was the first Christian school in the community. From this school came all the other Christian schools, teachers, pastors, and other leaders in the area. Please help us to keep it going. Each year several children receive Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. Our purpose in everything we are doing is to save souls.
