



The drilling of Emarti borehole within Emarti primary school compound in progress as the excited pupils of the school look on. The drilling has been completed and the hole has a good yield which will supply water to the primary school with a population of 700 pupils, a health centre, Emarti shopping centre residents, an upcoming secondary school and the general community who normally walk to Mara River to draw raw river water. The pupils of the school and the community in general are thankful to God for making Sawgrass Church such a blessing to them.



Oloitiko spring weir and the off take pipes from where the community will be drawing the water once the protection of the spring is completed. The girls have come to draw the water which now flows from one of the off take pipes. This spring will provide portable water to Oloitiko community throughout the year.



The digging of Kapsasian shallow well in progress. Concrete rings will be fitted to prevent the walls from caving in and a hand pump installed to help lift the safe drinking water from the well. The well will provide water to pupils of Kapsasian primary school, teachers and the surrounding community.
